you or any three or two of you to be our Commissioners to Examine Evidences on behalfe  
of a certain John Goddard Guardian of George Booth of the County afo in Relation  
to the bounds of Atract of Land Lying in the County afo Called Chance we therefore  
Required you or any three or two of you at sometime and place as to you or any three  
or two of you shall seem convenient you meet on the afo Land Called Chance you  
first having taken your oaths on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God according  
to act of Assembly in such case made and provided and there cause to come  
before you or any three or two of you all such Evidences as shall be to you or any  
three or two of you Nominated by the said Complainant or deff (if any) and that you or any three or  
two of you examine them upon their corporate Oathes to be by you or any three or two of you administered  
on the holy evangelist of Almighty God in the presence of the Complainant or deff (if any) touching the  
heath or Remembrance of their Knowledge or any thing that may relate to the cause afo and that Reducing  
the severall depositions into writing you send the same together with this Comission under you or any  
three or two of your hands to us to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient speed. Witness

afterwards in the same Court to wit this twenty first day of March one thousand seven hundred and Ninety one  
came into Court Thomas Gillis and William Hibble two of the afoemt nominated in the afoe Commission  
made return of the same with the severall depositions following and to the same Commission annexed  
May 26. 1731. same now witness named Thomas Gillis and William Hibble and was sworn to execute  
the witness Commission according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided before me —
