 Joy Hobbs of the County aforesaid in relation to the bounds of three tracts of Land lying in the County  
 aforesaid called Abington, Larneys Chance and White Oak Swamp, We therefore Require you or any  
 three or two of you, at some time and place as to you or any three or two of you, shall seem convenient  
 you meet on the aforesaid Lands called Abington, Larneys Chance and White Oak Swamp (you first  
 having taken your Oath on the holy Evangelist of almighty God according to act of assembly in  
 such case made and provided) and there cause to come before you or any three or two of you all  
 such evidence as shall be to you or any three or two of you, nominated by the said Complainant  
 or deft (if any) and that you or any three or two of you examine them upon their Corporal Oaths  
 to be by you or any three or two of you administered on the holy Evangelist of almighty God in the  
 presents of the Complainant or deft (if any) touching the truth or remembrance of their knowledge  
 or any thing that may relate to the cause aforesaid, and that Reducing the Several depositions into  
 writing you send the same together with this our Comission under you or any three or two of your hands  
 to us to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient speed with of you. Shanner Gent. one of our  
 Justices of our said Court the twentieth day of March in the Sixteenth year of our Dominion &c and done  
 One thousand Seven hundred and thirty

Afterwards ~~was~~ with this twenty first day of March one thousand Seven hundred and thirty one came here  
 into Court George Dashiell and Henry Ballard two of the Gent<sup>l</sup> nominated in the above Comission and  
 made Return therof, with the Several depositions therunto answered as followeth  
 To wit the 14<sup>th</sup> 1731. Then came before me the Subscriber one of the Lords proprietaries Justices of  
 the peace for the County of Cap<sup>t</sup> George Dashiell W<sup>th</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Walker and W<sup>th</sup> Henry Ballard and made  
 Oath.
