George Dashiell and Thom^o: Gillis two of the Gent^o: Mentioned in the above Commission and made Returne thereof with the Severall Depositions thereunto Annexed as followeth — ^(sworn and the widow of the said should have been deposed but was omitted and is recited at the foot of the following Depositions) Somerset County s^r: — The depositions of Witnesses taken at the plantation of George Godart in the County aforesaid the Ninth day of may am^o: Dom^o: 1731 by Vertue of a Commission to us directed out of his Lordships Court of Somerset County bearing date the 20th day of November am^o: Dom^o: 1731 for the Examining such Evidences as shall be produced to us touching the bounds of a tract of Land Called Toney Vineyard Viz^t: —

Isaac Noble aged fifty years or thereabouts being Sworn on the holy Evangelist of almighty God in Relation to the Upper Bounder of the Land Called Tonies Vineyard belonging to Benj^o: Mitchell taken at the Request of his Guardian W^m: Silsbee which did belong to John Fine saith that he was in Company with Steven Horsey and Col^o: W^m: Whittington Surveyer about thirty years agoe at the taking up the same Land he either marked or help to mark it or at least saw it marked a Cedar tree about seven^y yards below George Godarts Landing by a Vale next to the Landing for the first bounder of the said Land, this part is now Called in the Almatation^s Toyne Purchas and further saith not — the said tree is Down but the marks to be seen —

Peter Swerman aged Sixty years or thereabouts Deposeth and saith that he was in Company at the same time with Isaac Noble at the Survey of the Land Called Tonies Vineyard and that he saw the Cedar Described in Isaac Nobles Deposition marked for a bounder of said Land and further saith not —
