now here to the aforesd Penelope to give Security to the afo Thomas as afo and
it is Sayed unto the Said Penelope by the Court now here that she Security for
Cost as aforesd to the aforesd Thomas During this terme should give at her
perill — And because that the aforesd Penelope now here nor at any
time During this terme hath given Security for Cost as the afo Thomas —
Therefore it is Considered that the afo Penelope take Nothing by her will
and Declaration afo but that she and her pledges of prosecuting be in mercy
and that the aforesd Thomas go thereof without day and further it is —
Considered by the same Court that the aforesd Thomas recover against the
aforesd Penelope one hundred forty and three pounds of Tobacco for his Costs
and Charges which he hath Sustained by occasion of the premises afo unto
the same Thomas by the Court now here according to the forme of the Statute
in such Case made and provided of his aforesd adjudged —
