Thomas Enchmarsh Esq: of attachment against his debt the tenor whereof followeth in these words, vizt —  
Somerset & Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the province of Maryland

and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sher: of Somerset County Greeting we command  
you that you attack any the Goods Chattells Rights or Ceditts of Thomas Enchmarsh and  
Company Sale of Somerset County Merch: if they should be found in your bailey with  
to the Value of twentyone pounds Eight Shillings Current money of Maryland and  
one thousand pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part  
thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before our  
Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridging Creek the third Tuesday  
of March next then and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to  
and for the use of a certain John Murray unless the said Thomas Enchmarsh  
and Company by themselves or their Attorneys shall appear and Answer unto  
the said John Murray in a plea of trespass upon the case &c According to  
Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your bailey you make known  
unto the Person or persons in whose hands you make the attachment that he  
she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held aforesd to shew  
Cause if any he she or they have why the same good Chattells Right or Ceditts so  
attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof  
had and made according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided  
if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this with that  
you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesd and have  
you there and there this with witness I am: Hopkins Gent: Chief Justice of our  
Said Court the twenty day of November: in the seventeenth year of our Sovereign  
King George: one thousand Seven hundred and Thaly one

At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the twenty first day of March and dñe. One thousand and  
Seven hundred and Thaly one being the day of the return of the said Writ cometh the said John Murray by his attorney  
aforesd and the Sher: of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise cometh and makes Return of  
the same Writ whereof Endorsed in these words following vizt — By virtue of the within Writ to me directed to  
the Justice within mentioned I Certifie that upon the tenth day of February One thousand Seven hundred and Thaly  
One I did attack in the hands of Philip Forington all the goods and Chattells Rights and Ceditts of the within  
named Thomas Enchmarsh and Company for a thousand and One hundred and Thaly Six pounds of Tobacco of the  
Value of twenty one pounds Eight Shillings Current money, and further I Certifie that I did make known  
unto the said Philip Forington that he do and appear at the time and place wherein I am commanded to shew  
as by the within Precept I am commanded to answer Joshua Caldwell Sher:
