

hundred and thirty Seven pounds of tobacco and no more, and because the aforesaid Richard denys not this, but the same allegation confesseth to be true, prayes Judgment and those damage, above Confessed together with his costs and charges, aforesaid to him adjudged £¹⁰⁰

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is Considered that the aforesaid Richard Gildart recover against the aforesaid Charles Young his damage aforesaid to the aforesaid Seven hundred and Thirty Seven pounds of tobacco by the same Charles in form aforesaid Confessed as also two hundred and Seventy five - - - pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges aforesaid to the same Richard at his Request by the Court heretofore and Consent of the parties aforesaid Adjudged which certain damages in the whole do amount to £³⁷⁵ 100 pounds of tobacco and 100 pounds of tobacco and 100 aforesaid Charles in Mercy £¹⁰⁰.

Lg. Susannah Wodie of Somerset Esq. Isaac Wheeler Late of Somerset County planter was attacked
for Isaac Wheeler to answer unto Susannah Wodie ofapele of the p[ro]p[erty] upon the case &c.

And whereupon the said Susannah by Lewis Gale her attorney Complaines that whereas the Said Isaac the Sixteenth day of March and Dow: Seventeen hundred and Ninety, Ninety one was indebted unto the said Susannah in three pounds Six Shillings and ten pence currency as by Certain note by the Said Isaac signed and hereunto annexed dated the day and year aforesaid and may in Court appear and being so thereof Indebted the Said Isaac in Consideration thereof the day and year aforesaid at the Place aforesaid within the Just aforesaid by the Note aforesaid upon himselfe assumed and to the said Susannah then and there did faithfully Promise that he the Said Isaac the Said three pounds six Shillings and ten pence when he Should be thereto requested he would well and faithfully pay and Content NEVER the less the Said Isaac his promise and Assumption aforesaid informed aforesaid Nothing regarding but Plotting and fraudulently Intending the said Susannah in that parte craftily and Subtilly to Deceive and Defraud the said three pounds Six Shillings and ten pence aforesaid to the said Susannah according to the Content of the said Note altho the same to do the said Isaac by the said Susannah the aforesd Sixteenth day of March in the Year aforesd and often afterwards at Somerset County aforesaid within the Just aforesaid he was there unto requested hath not paid but the same to him hitherto to pay hath refused and still doth refuse and Deny to the Damage of the said Susannah of Six pounds like money and thereupon she brings Suite - L Gale Esq. pleads for the said Isaac And the aforesaid Isaac Wheeler in his proper person Comes and Defends the said and Injury where: and says that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Susannah above Against him complained, and as to the Damages of the same Susannah by him by occasion of the Premises in that part sustained the same Isaac ^{said} confesseth that the aforesaid Susannah ^{had} sustained Damages by occasion of the Premises beyond his costs and charges by him about her Suit in that part
