 Magan or that the said John Magan shall be therein convicted that then he the said
 John Magan shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body
 in Execution to the Sher. of Somerset County or that he the said Richard Knight will
 do the same for him &c. And afterwards the said John Magan by Willm
 Beekingham his attorney Comes and Defends the said and Injary When &c. and
 sayth that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid John Finch nor can he say but
 that the said John Magan did assume upon himself in manner and forme as the
 aforesaid John Finch above against him complained and as to the damage of the said
 John Finch by him by occasion of the Premises in that part sustained the same
 John Magan saith and Confesseth that the aforesaid John Finch has sustained Damages
 by occasion of the Premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that
 part apposed to five hundred pounds of Pork and no more and because the aforesaid John
 Finch denyes not this but the same Allegation Confesseth to be true pray Judgment
 and those Damages above Confessed together with this Costs and Charges aforesaid to him
 adjudged &c. Therefore by Consent of the Parties aforesaid it is Considered that the aforesaid
 John Finch recover against the aforesaid John Magan his Damages aforesaid to the aforesaid five hundred
 and fifty pounds of Pork by the same John Magan in forme aforesaid Confessed as also
 265. Two hundred & sixty five pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges
 aforesaid to the same John Finch at his request by the Court here and Consent of the Parties
 aforesaid adjudged which certain Damages in the whole do amount to five hundred and
 fifty pounds of Pork and pounds of Tobacco
 and the aforesaid Cost.

 as the aforesaid Ignatius Waser the sixteenth day of August and now: Oath the said seven hundred and thirty
 one at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court by certain Writing
 obligatory granted himselfe hold and firmly bound unto the aforesaid John Rider in the aforesaid
 sum of fifteen pounds two shillings and eight pence Current money of Maryland to be
 paid unto the said John Rider when there of afterwards he should be Required, yett the aforesaid
