Thereupon a certain Richard Knight of Somersel County Planter, here in Court in his own proper person undertakes for the Said John Magan that if in case the Said John Finch Shall recover Judgment in the Plea afo^rd against the Said John Magan or that the Said John Magan Shall be therin Convict that then he the Said John Magan Shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his body in Execution to the Sheriff of Somersel County or that he the Said Richard Knight will do the same for him: — And afterward the Said John Magan by Willm^m — Beckingham his attorney comes and Defends the said action and Injury when^r and sayeth he cannot gainsay the action afo^rd of the afo^rd John Finch nor can he say but that the said John Magan did a sum upon himself in manner and forme as the afo^rd John Finch above against him complained and as to the damage of the Said John Finch by him by occasion of the Premises in that part sustained the same John Magan saith and confesseth that the afo^rd John Finch has Sustained Damages by occasion of the Premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed to five hundred pounds of Pork and no more and because the afo^rd John Finch denys not this but the same Allegation confesseth to be true prays Judgment and those Damages above Confessed together with his Costs and Charges afo^rld to him adjudged: — Therefore by Consent of the Parties aforesd it is Considered that the afo^rd John Finch Recover against the afo^rd John Magan his Damages afo^rd to the afo^rd five hundred and fifty pounds of Pork by the same John Magan in forme aforesd Confessed as also 265 Two hundred & Sixty four pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges afo^rld to the same John Finch at his request by the Court head and Consent of the Parties afo^rd Adjudged which certain Damages in the whole do amount to five hundred and fifty pounds of Pork and and the aforesd Dft^r pounds of Tobacco
