unto the aff George Gale in the aff fifty Six bushells of Corn to be paid unto the  
Said George when he should be there to required which the Said George Gale on  
the first day of June one thousand Seven hundred and thirty one at Somers-  
County aff within the Jur: of this Court did assign unto the aff Betty Gale all his  
Right title and Interest to the Said obligation the Condition of the Said obliga-  
tion then remaining Unperformed of which said Assignment the Said Walter  
Jacobs on the tenth day of August and Year Last Mentioned at Somerset County
