And thereupon the said John Magan the first day of October anno Domini Seventeen
hundred and thirty at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was
Indebted unto the said John Dennis Jndt. in fifteen hundred and Nine
Pounds of Tobacco and thirteen pounds ten shillings and six pence Current
money of Maryland as by Account hereto annexed may in Court appear and
bring to thereof Indebted the said John Magan in Consideration thereof the day and
year aforesaid at Somerset County aforesaid Within the Jurisdiction upon himself did assume and to the
said John Dennis then and there did faithfully promised that the said John Magan
the said fifteen hundred Sixty Nine pounds of Tobacco and thirteen pounds ten shillings
and six pence to the said John Dennis when he should be thereunto requested he
would well and faithfully pay and Content Nevertheless the said John Magan his
Promise and Assumption aforesaid made nothing regarding but Plotting and
fraudulently Intending the said John Dennis in that part Craftily and Subtilly to
Deceive and Defraud the aforesaid fifteen hundred Sixty Nine pounds of Tobacco and thirteen
pounds ten shillings and six pence to the said John Dennis Altho the same to do
the said John Magan by the aforesaid John Dennis on the aforesaid first day of October in the year
aforesaid often afterwards at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction he was therewith
requested hath not paid or to him for the same in any sort Contented but that said to
him neither to pay or in any sort to Content hath refused and still doth Refuse and
Deny Whereupon he saith he is worse and hath damage to the Value of twenty pounds
Current money and three thousand pounds of Tobacco and thereupon he brings suit

Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of August next, and he had it and the same day is given to
the aforesaid John Dennis his also to do.

All which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of August anno Domini One thousand seven hun-
dred and Thirty One came againe as well the aforesaid John Dennis as the aforesaid John Magan by their
attorneys aforesaid, and whereupon the same John Magan prays further Leave therof to Imparte here-
unto the next Court, and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Dennis his also to do.

All which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of November One thousand Seven hundred and Thirty
One came againe as well the aforesaid John Dennis as the aforesaid John Magan by their attorneys aforesaid
and whereupon the said John Magan pray further Leave therof to Imparte hereunto the next Court to be
held it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Dennis his also to do.

All which said next Court to wit the twenty first day of March One thousand Seven hundred and Thirty
One came againe as well the aforesaid John Dennis as the aforesaid John Magan by their attorney
aforesaid
