Dr. William Holland. [Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Robert Houston
Robert Houston. late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Robert Houston of Somerset County in the province of Maryland if he should be found in his bailie wch and him should safe keepe so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidg Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to satisfy William Holland as well of a certain debt of one hundred pds good and Lawfull money of the aforesaid County which the same William Holland in his said Lordships County Court of Somerset before the Justices thereof at Dwidg Creek recovered against him as of one thousand and fifty seven pounds of tobacco which to the same William Holland in the same Court were adjudged for his damages which he had by Quasion of the detaining of that same debt whereof he is Convict &c.

Att whiche said third Tuesday of March to witt the twenty first day of the same month and day one thousand Seven hundred and thirty one being the day of the returne of the said writt (unto the said Wm. Holland by Lavinia Gale his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise comette and made the returne thereof to the said Court endorsed in these words following bid hereto come in custody of Jos. Baldwelle &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid Robert Houston present here in Court in his proper person (and being by the Sheriff to the bar) is at the prayer of the aforesaid William by his attorney aforesaid committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remaine until the aforesaid William of his debt and damages aforesaid should be fully satisfied &c. the said Sheriff (to witt) Joshua Col. wile Gent: present here in Court took charge of the said Rob. Houston accordingly &c.

John Lay, bond - [Somerset County in Maryland p. I know all men by these presents that we John Lay, John Donelson and Thomas Collins ale of Somerset County in the province aforesaid are holden and firmly bound unto Lavinia Gleuning Orphan off Godwick Gleuning decd. in his full and just sum of one hundred and thirty one pounds and two pence currant money to be paid unto the said Lavinia Gleuning her heirs executors administrators or assignes to her which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves and either of us heirs executors and administrators for the whole and in the whole jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our Seal and dated this 21st day of March anno: Dom: 1731.

The condition of the above Obligation is such that whenever the Councillor General hath transmitted into this Court the amount of the estate of Godwick Gleuning decd. wherein it is found that there is balance due to the above said Orphan the sum of Sixty five pounds and Seven shillings currant money therefore the above said John Lay his executors or Administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above named Lavinia Gleuning the aforesaid sum of Sixty five pounds and Seven shillings currant money according to act of Assembly and & decd. wch when the said shall amount fulfilleth to her the same to then the above Obligation to be void & none effect otherwise to remaine in full force & demandable
