Court that the aforesaid Samuel Tomlinson be discharged for the future from paying of taxes for the aforesaid negro
as by the petition aforesaid is said &c.

Whereas a certain William Reynolds an English Boy was formerly bound by the Court unto
a certain James Shiley of Somerset County, and forasmuch as the said William Reynolds would
not Learn any thing of Shiley's trade, but would run away from the said Shiley

The said Shiley came here into Court and prays that the aforesaid Wm Reynolds may be removed from him &
that he may be discharged from a former bond by him entered into for to Learn the said Reynolds his
trade &c and forasmuch as it doth appear to the Court here that the said William Reynolds was not mis-
used or abused by the said James Shiley, therefore the aforesaid James Shiley is discharged from a
aforesaid bond as aforesaid is said &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid William Reynolds is bound by the Court unto John Bishop un-
-til he arrives at the age of twenty one year, the said William Reynolds to serve his said Master the
full term aforesaid, during which term the said William his said Master well and faithfully shall serve
