allege to the County &c. the said Mary Bouiter present herein Court is ordered to  
Give Security to Save harmless the Justices of Somerset County and their Successors for the time  
being as also the Inhabitants of said County from all sorts Charges and troubles whatsoever for or by  
Reason of the birth maintenance & bringing up of the said Child &c. -

Whereupon a certain Edward Bouiter of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his pro-  
per person ~~and~~ undertakes for the said Mary Bouiter and acknowledged himself to owe & be  
Indebted unto his Lordship the right honorable the Lord proprietary his heirs and Successors in the  
sum of fifteen pounds sterling good and Lawfull money of England to be Levied of his Goods &c.  
Chattell Lands and tenements to the use of the aforesaid County of Somerset if it happen  
that the aforesaid Edward Bouiter his heirs Executors and Administrators do not from time to time  
and at all times hereafter acquit discharge and Save harmless, as well the Justices of Somerset  
County and their Successors for the time being, as also the Inhabitants of the same County of  
from all sorts Charges and troubles whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintenance Nourishing  
and bringing up of the said Child, and also do not save & keep them Indebted from all other  
suits Charges troubles and demands whatsoever touching or concerning the same, these words above -  
Recognizance to be in full force and virtue otherwise &c. -

His Lordship } Dorman Death appears according to his Recognizance and is discharged, and is order  
Dorman Death. } ed to give new Recognizance for his good behaviour and appearance at August Court  
next &c. whereupon the said Dorman Death with Michael Dorman his Family both  
present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and Stand justly  
Indebted unto his Lordship the right honorable the Lord proprietary in the Sum of ten pounds good  
and Lawfull money of England to be made and Levied to the use of  
his said Lordship his heirs and Successors - if it happen that the said Dorman Death do not  
make his personall appearance before the Justices of his said Lordship's County Court of Somerset to  
be held at dividing Creek the third wednesday of August next, and do not answer unto such matters  
as shall be then & there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalf tending to the breach  
of the peace, and that he doth depart without Leave of the Court, then the above Recognizance to  
Remain in full force and virtue, otherwise &c.

His Lordship } Avery Morgan appears according to his Recognizance and is discharged and ordered to  
Avery Morgan. } Give new Recognizance for his appearance at August Court next to answer a present
