

June Court -- 1732 -- 189

Somerset County Gentlemen <sup>in Sessyng</sup> both present here in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland in the sum of ten pounds for each good and lawfull money of England of their Goods and Cattell, Lands and tenements severally to be made and levied his hours and prouers. if it happen that the aforesaid Avery Morgan do not make his personale appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidning next the third Tuesday of August next and do not answer unto his said Lordship of and concerning a certain presentment against him for fornication and stand and abide the judgment of the Court Hereon to have the above recognizance to be in full force and vertue he otherwise do.

His Lordship -- We of the Orphan Jury for the body of Somerset County do present John Evans Tene of Stepney  
John Evans said. } parish for not keeping Thomas Fowler to his trade assigned by the Court. —  
John Evans said. } Wm Jones foreman.

The said John Evans being present before Court, says of the premises aforesaid he is not guilty thereof, and therof forbyale putt himself upon the County he. whereupon the Court having Inspected the bond by which thos Fowler was bound to the afo Evans; and for as much as it doth appear to the Court that the afo Fowler is free. Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the presentment aforesaid be quashed, and that the aforesaid John Evans be thenceforth acquit &c.

The same -- We of the Orphan Jury for the body of Somerset County do present James Shirley of Calshot,  
James Shirley } parish for not keeping Wm Reynolds according to order off Court but has made sale of him.  
James Shirley } Wm Jones foreman.

The said James Shirley present before Court in his proper persons say that of the premises aforesaid he is not guilty thereof, and therof forbyale putt himself upon the County he.

And for as much as it doth appear to the Court here that the aforesaid James Shirley had not abused nor misused the aforesaid William Reynolds as above against him is complained.

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid presentment be quashed, and that the aforesaid James Shirley be thenceforth acquit &c.

His Lordship -- Somerset To Be it Remembered that upon the twentieth day of June anno domini One thousand Seven hundred  
Gathenice Taylor. } and thirtieth year came beforeto Somerset County Court Thomas Blunt who prosecutes for the said  
Lord Proprietary in his County aforesaid and gives the Court to understand and be informed that  
aforesaid Gathenice Taylor late of Somerset County Esqre the tenth day of March one thousand Seven hundred  
and thirtieth year at the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication and  
had born of her body a bastard child against the peace of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary his Good  
Rule and Government and also against the form of the act of Assembly in such case made and provided  
whereof the said Thomas Blunt for the said Lord Proprietary prayes advise of the Court & that due process of  
Law may issue. — T Blunt Esqre did protest —

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the Law.
