by whom &c. who neither &c. to recognize &c. and afterwards in the same Court came Henry
Baleard and William Lane Gent^l. Coronors of County afo and made return that they had there
ready twelve &c. as aforesaid they were commanded, and therof Cometh before the aforesaid Justices
Last mentioned the Jury, and the Jurors of that same Jury by the aforesaid Coronors being sworn

without day &c. whereupon the aforesaid William Horsey is ordered by the Court to give
Security for the payment of the severall Officers their fees due by mean of the premises aforesaid
but for want thereof the said William Horsey is committed into the Custody of the Sher. of
Somerset County thereto remaine &c. the said Sher. to witt Joshua Caldwell Gent^l. present here in
