June Court 1711, p. 1
and David. One thousand Seven hundred and Thirty One came hereinto Court before his Lordships
Justices at Dwidning Creek in Somerset County to represent William Horsey in his proper person &
that alsoeing off the Information aforesaid, and Say, that he is not found guilty and of
this brought himself upon the Country, and Thomas Bluet who for him said Lordship in that
prosecutes Likewise: Whereupon the aforesaid William Horsey at the prayer of the aforesaid
Thomas Bluet (who for him said Lordship in that part prosecutes,) is ordered by the Court to give
Security for his good behaviour and appearance before his said Lordships Justices of the next
Court to be held at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of June next to answer the premises aforesaid
but for want whereof the said William Horsey is by the same Court committed into the custody
of the Sheriff of Somerset County to remaine till —

Att whiche said next Court to witt the twentieth day of June and anno Domini One thousand and Seven hundred
and as well by a presentment made before his said lordship in that Court prosecute for
and thirty two before me said Lordship further came the said William Hervey in custody off the
said (in his proper person) in whose custody before way committed, Had upon command way
given to the Coroners of Somerset County that immediately they shoule cause to beare twelve
day by whom soe who neither doe to recognis her and afterwards in the same Court came Henry
Baleard and William Lane gent^m Coronor of that County aforesaid and made returne that they had there
ready twelve men as aforesaid they were commanded, and had off Cometh before the aforesaid Justices
Last mentioned the Jury, and Had now of that same Jury by the aforesaid Coroners being suspec-
tione and Likewise failed came to witt Edward Rownd, James Macmorie, Joseph Howton, John Atkinson,
John Webb, Robert Michell, John Tull, John Brightton, Lazarus Maddox, Thomas Glenn, John Don-
nelson and John Records, who to say the truth in the premises being called byed and sworn, upon
then both did say that the aforesaid William Hervey ^{in his proper person} the premises aforesaid as by the Informa-
tion above specified; whereupon all and Singular the premises by the said Court fully under-
stood.

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid William Horsey be quiet and go thence without day or whereupon the aforesaid William Horsey is to be by the Court to give security for the payment of the several Officers then due by means of the premises aforesaid but for want hereof the said William Horsey is committed into the custody of the Provost of Powys County to remain &c. the said Provost with Joshua Edwards Gent. present here in Court took charge of said William Horsey accordingly &c. —
