And in manner to witt, at the Court held for the County of Somerset at Dwiding Green the twenty first Day of March and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty one before his Lordships Justice of the same Court Cometh the aforesaid William Horsey according to certain Requirance by him and his pledge in that part first acknowledged in his proper person, and hath a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid, and says that he is not guilty thereof and of this he puts himself upon the Country, and Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> who for his said Lordship in that followeth Likewise ---

Whereupon the aforesaid William Horsey at the prayer of the aforesaid Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> (who for his said Lordship in that part proceut) is ordered by the Court here to give Security for his good behaviour and appearance before the Justice of his said Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dwiding Green the third Wednesday of June then next to answer the Indictment aforesaid but for want thereof the said William Horsey is committed into the Custody of the Sherif of Somerset County there to remain &c ---

All which said next Court to witt the twentieth of June and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two before his said Lordships Justice came as well the aforesaid Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> who for his said Lordship in that part followeth as the aforesaid William Horsey in his proper person <sup>under</sup> custody of the Sherif of the County <sup>of Somerset</sup> before that time was committed for the same

Wherupon Command was given to the Coroners of Somerset County that immediately they should come to come here twelve by whom they who neither to be requir'd and afterwards in the same Court came Henry Ballard and William Lane Gent<sup>l</sup> Coroners of the County afo and made return that they had there ready twelve by as aforesaid they were commanded, and there of before the afo Justice Last mentioned Cometh the Jury, and the Jurors of that same Jury by the afo Coroners being Impannelled and Likewise Called came to witt Edward Rownd, James Manoria Joseph Houston John Alkinson John Webb, Robert Mitchell, John Tule, John Broughton Lazarus Maddox, Thomas Collins, John ~~son~~ Donaldson and John Records, who to say the truth in the premises, being duly Olected byed and Sworne ---

And forasmuch as it doth appear to the Court here that One of the Jurors afo Impannelled and Sworn to witt Edward Rownd, was foreman of the Grand Jury that returned the Bill of Indictment aforesaid Bilia Vera Whereupon at the prayer of Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> who for his said Lordship in this behalf proceut, the aforesaid Edward Rownd sworn on the Jury, & withdrawn, and all the rest of the Jurors sworn as above were accordingly.
