On the Back side of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was thus,

Edward W. Bales Vera Edward Rownd foremen.—

And in manner to wit, at the Court held for the County of Somerset at Bridgwater the twenty first  
day of March anno domini. One thousand Seven hundred and Thirty one before his Lordships Justice of the  
same Court cometh the aforesaid William Horsey according to a certain Recognizance by him and his  
pledges in that part first acknowledged in his proper person, and hath alerning of the judgment  
aforesaid, and says that he is not guilty thereof and of this he putteth himself upon the barony, and Larmi Gale  
Esq<sup>r</sup> who for his said Lordship is that followeth Likewise. —

Whereupon the aforesaid William Horsey at the prayer of the said Leon Hale Esq<sup>r</sup> (who  
for his said Lordship in that part prosecute) is ordered by the Court to give security for his  
good behaviour and appearance before the Justices of his said Lordship's County Court of Common  
law to be held at Bridgwater the third Monday of June next to answer the indictment aforesaid  
but for want whereof the said William Horsey is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of  
Somerset County there to remaine etc -

All which said went forth to witness the twentieth of June and Dow. One thousand seven  
hundred and thirty two before his said Lordships Justice came at wale the aforesaid Lewis Galt Esq  
who for his said Lordships in that part followeth as the aforesaid William Horsey in his proper  
person <sup>under</sup> & custod of the aforesaid County  
whereas he had before that time been remanded for the cause of

Wherupon Command was given to the Coroners of Somerset County that Immediately they shoud  
Cause to Come before twelve Jurors by whom the same who neither did to Recommitte and afterward in the same  
Court came Henry Balkand and William Lane Esq<sup>r</sup>. Coroners of the County ad<sup>d</sup> and made returne that  
they had had ready twelve Jurors as aforesaid they were command ed, and therof before the ad<sup>d</sup> Just.  
c<sup>r</sup> Last mentioned Comette the Jury, and the Jurors of that same Jury by the ad<sup>d</sup> Coroners being Inpa-  
nnelled and Likewise called came to witt Edward Rownd, James Memrie Joseph Houston John Alkinson  
John Webb, Robert Mitchell, John Tule, John Broughton Lazarus Maddox, Thomas Collins, John ~~Pen~~ Donald-  
son and John Records, who to say the truth in the premises, being duly Chched tyed and Sworne -  
and forasmuch as it doth appeare to the Court here that One of the Jurors ad<sup>d</sup> Inpannelled and sworn to witt  
Edward Rownd, was foreman of the Grand Jury that Indorred the Bill of Indictment abovesaid bill a ver  
thereupon at the prayer of Lavin Galleg<sup>r</sup> who for his said Lordship in this behalfe prosecute<sup>d</sup> the aforesaid  
Edward Rownd, sworn on the Jury, withdrawn, and all the rest of the Jurors sworn as above were  
and remaine.
