Wherupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court here understood -

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid William Horsey be quiet and go thereof without day &c. also it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid William Horsey give Security for the payment of the several Officers their fees due by reason of the premises aforesaid, but for want thereof the said William Horsey is committed into the Custody of the Sher. of Somerset County here to remain by the said Sher. to wit Joshua Belwelle Gent present here in Court took charge of said William Horsey accordingly &c.
