Levin Gale Esq. who for his said Lordship in that part followeth Likewise &c. whereupon the aforesaid John Webb pray Leave to <sup>leave of</sup> impare here-until next Court and he had it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Levin Gale Esq. who &c. - at which said next Court to witt the twentieth day of June and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and thirty two came here as well the afo Levin Gale Esq. who &c. as the aforesaid John Webb in his proper person, and the said John Webb relinquisheth his Verification by him above presented, says that he cannot deny but that he is Gilty of the premises aforesaid in the Information aforesaid specified above upon him supposed, in manner and form as by the Information aforesaid above against him supposed, whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court being freely understood . . .

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid John Webb pay to his said Lordship the Lord proprietary Six hundred pounds of tobacco for his fine <sup>for</sup> the formation in the Information aforesaid contained whereof his Court (to the use of Somerset County) and that the John Webb be taken &c. and afterwards at the prayer of the afo Levin Gale Esq. the aforesaid John Webb is committed into the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County until he pay the fine aforesaid and all the Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid, the said Sher present here in Court took charge of the said John Webb accordingly &c. -

The Jurors for the Right honorable the Lord proprietary that now is William Horsey } for the body of Somerset County upon their Oath do present that William Horsey Late of Somerset County planter the fifth day of January in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and thirty One with force and arms &c. at the County of Somerset aforesaid in and upon a certain John Goldsmith in the peace of God and the aforesaid Lord proprietary then and there being an assault made and him then and there beat wounded and evil Intreated so that of his Life it was greatly despaired and other Injuries to him then and there offered to his great Damage of him and said John and against the peace of the Right honorable the Lord proprietary - <sup>the</sup> Robert p. Dad. properly - the above Bill of Inditment sent up to the Grand Jury with the Leave of the Court

On the backside of the foregoing Bill of Inditment it was thus Endored vid. Billia Vera Jan. Rownd Foreman &c.

Now hereat this day to witt the twentieth day of June One thousand seven hundred and thirty two before his Lordship Justice of the County Court of Somerset now hold at dividing fees (with the aforesaid William Horsey in his proper person under Custody of the Sher. of the aforesaid County of Somerset and hath allowing of the Inditment aforesaid, and saith that he is not Gilty thereof and of this he puts himself upon the Country, and Thomas Bluet who for his said Lordship in that part followeth Likewise &c. whereupon Command was given to the Jurors of Somerset County that immediately they should come to come here ~~to~~ <sup>by</sup> whom &c. who neither to recognize &c. because as well &c. and afterwards in the same Court came the Grand Jury to witt William Lave and Henry Ballard Gent<sup>l</sup> and returned that they
