

June Court --- 1732 --- 195 ---

They had there ready twelve Jurors as aforesaid they were Commanded and the Jurors of that same Jury by the aforesaid Court were sworn and being called came to witt, James Madsenmore, Joseph Houston, John Atkinson, John Webb, Robert Mitchell, John Tull, John Broughton, Lazarus Maddox, Thomas Collins, John Donelson, John Records and Robert Givans who today the truth of the premises being asked tried and sworn upon their Oaths did say that the said William Dorsey is guilty of the trespass and assault aforesaid in manner and form as by the Indictment aforesaid above against him imposed. Wherupon also and Piquar the premises by the Court here being seen, heard, and fully understood, It is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid William Dorsey pay to his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court here upon him imposed for and by Occasion of the trespass and assault aforesaid wherof his fine aforesaid he is found five hundred pounds of Tobacco, and that the said William Dorsey be taken to Satisfie his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid - Wherupon the aforesaid William Dorsey is Committed under the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County here to remain until he Satisfie the several Officers his fees due by Occasion of the premises he wherupon the said Sher. to witt Joshua Roweke hath present herein Court took Charge of said William Dorsey accordingly &c. -

Martin Henry. } that now is & for the body of Somerset County upon their oaths do Present that Martin Henry late of Somerset County Carpenter - the fifteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty two with force and Arms &c. at the County of Somerset aforesaid in and upon Alexander John Follers (the said John Follers then being Constable of great Moomie hundred in the County of Somerset aforesaid) in the Peace of God and the aforesaid Lord Proprietary and in the Execution of his office aforesaid then and there being an assault made on him then and there beat Wounded and Evil Intreated so that of his Life it was Greatly Despaired and other Enamities to him then and there offered to the Grievous Damage of him the said ^{John} and against the Peace of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary &c. and against the form of the act of Assembly in that case made and provided by J. Bluet of said prop^{ty} -

Wherupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the said Martin Henry if he to answer &c. and afterwards in the their same Court before his Lordship Justice & dividing Court to witt the twentieth day of June and did. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came the said Martin Henry in his proper person and had shewing of the Indictment aforesaid, and says that he is not guilty thereof and of this he puts himself upon the Country and Thomas Bluet who for his said Lordship in this behalfs presenter Likewise, afterwards the said Martin Henry present
