Justice of our said Court the twenty second Day of March In the Seventeenth
Year of our Dominion & Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and
Thirty one - At which Said third Tuesday of June last with the twentieth day of the
Same Month anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty one being the
day of the return of the Said Writ cometh the aforesd Levin Gale in his proper
Person and the Sherif of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was
Directed Comes and Makes Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed Vizt: -
According to the Within Writ to me directed I have attached to the Value of
Six pounds currant Money of Maryland in the hands of George Bailey and
Abigail Hibell as Witness my hand - J. Caldwell Sherif

Whereupon the aforesaid George Bailey Garnishee of the aforesaid John Persons altho' solemnly called
gave not nor know cause why he but makes default -

Whereupon the aforesaid Levin Gale present herein Court in his proper person prays that upon giving
Security according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided the aforesd sum of Six pounds Curr.
money so as aforesaid attached may be condemned in the hands of the aforesaid George Bailey as of
the Rights and Creditts of the aforesaid John Persons toward satisfying unto him the same sum of
five pounds Curr. money mentioned in his attachment aforesaid; as also all Costs accruing by means of
his former attachment to which is to him granted. &c.

Thereupon a certain William Stoughton of Somerset County Gent present herein Court in his proper person
undertakes for the Said Levin Gale that in case the Said John Persons shall at any time within a year and a day
appear and make all or any part of the Said Levin Gale claim against him, to be satisfied, or otherwise
due before the laying off the attachment aforesaid that then the Said Levin Gale shall make restitution unto the
Said John Persons of all, or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undebt or that the said William
Stoughton will do the same for him &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid sum of Six pounds Curr. money
so as aforesaid attached may be condemned in the hands of the said George Bailey as of the rights and cred-
its of the Said John Persons toward satisfying unto the Said Levin Gale the aforesaid sum of five
pounds mentioned in the attachment aforesaid as also all Costs accruing theron, and that the aforesaid Levin
Gale have knowldege of his Recomission against the said Geo. Bailey according to act of Assembly &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid Abigail Hibell Garnishee as aforesaid is by course of the aforesaid Levin Gale
discharged from the attachment aforesaid -
