and in Obedience to the aforesaid warrant the following attachment was issued against the Goods
and Chattels Rights or Credits of the aforesaid Theophilus Dennis the tenor whereof followeth
in these words vid - Somerset Esq: Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of
Maryland and avallon Lord Baron of Baltimore Esq to the Just. of Somerset County Greeting we com-
mand you that you attach any the Goods Chattels lights or Credits of Theophilus Dennis late of
Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your Baileys worth to the value of One pound
fourteen shillings curr: money and three hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have had
Same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same
before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday
of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of
Alberto Joshua Merrill unless the said Theophilus Dennis by himself or his attorney shall appear
and answer unto the said Joshua Merrill in a plea of trespass upon the case so -

according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailey with you make known unto
the person or persons in whose hand you make the same attachment that he or they be and
appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause
if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattells Rights or Credits so
attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Executed -
Whereof had and made according to act of Assembly in such case made and
Provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute
this will that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place
aforesaid and have you then and there this will witness Sam: Hopkins -
