Custody safe keep so that you have the Same before our Justices of our
County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June
Next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and
for the Use of Alexander Adam Spence Sen: Unless the Said W^m Shockley -
by himself or his Attorney shall appear and Answer unto the Said Adam
Spence Sen: in a Plea of trespass upon the Case &c: According to Law and
that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto
the Person or Persons in whose hands you made make the Same Attachment
that he She or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be
held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he She or they have why the Same
goods Chattels Rights or Credits so Attached in his her or their hands -
ought not to be condemned and Execution there of had and made According
