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By himself or his Attorney shall appear and Answer unto the Said Samuel Hopkins Junr: in a plea of trespass upon the Case &c: According to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the Person or persons in whose hands you make the Same Attachment that he she or they be and Appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the Same goods Chattells and Execution thereof had and made according to act of Assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this Writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writt Witness Samuel Hopkins Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty fifth day of March In the Seventeenth Year of our Dominion King James one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two. At which said this last day of June to witt the twentieth day of the Same Month ann: Dominion one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two being the ^{day of the} turne of the Said Writt -

Come th the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sher: of Somerset County to Whome the foregoing Writt was Directed Likewise Comes and makes returne thereof to the Court here Endorsed Vrit: By Verue of the within Writt to me Directed to the Justices within mentioned I Certifie that upon the 15: day of this Instant June one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two I Attached as the goods and Chattells of the within Thomas Richardson in the hands of Nathaniel Cooper five pounds Nineteen Shilling and one penny Currant money of this Province and five hundred pounds of Tobacco and I further Certifie that by Littleton Townsend and Thomas Latham make known unto the Said Nath: that he be and appear at the time and place within Contained shewg: as by the within precept I am Comanded so answer - Joshua Caldwell Sher:

Where upon the aforesaid Nathaniel Cooper Garnishee of the aforesaid Thomas Richardson in his proper person appears and says that he cannot garnisay but that he hath of the goods and Chattells of the said Thomas Richardson in his hands to witt, one Wile Table, one Chest, one Lugg and pair of Blankett, one Keying pan, one ax, one grubbing hoe one Linen Wheel, and one bedstead, all which things were valued by the Court to four pounds sixteen Shillings Currant money, nor can he say but that the same Goods ought to be condemned in his hands for the use of the Said Samuel Hopkins as of the Goods and
