All which said next Court to witt the twenty first day of March Ann<sup>d</sup> Dom<sup>n</sup> one thousand Seven hundred and thirty one Came againe as well the afo<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Holland as the afo<sup>r</sup> John Riggini J<sup>r</sup>: by their Attorney afo<sup>r</sup> and the aforesaid John Prays further Leave thereof to Imparle here untill the next Court and he hath it and the Same day is given to the aforesaid William here also J.

All which said next Court to witt the twenty eith day of June Ann<sup>d</sup> Dom<sup>n</sup> One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two Came againe as well the aforesaid William Holland as the aforesaid John Riggini by their Attorneys aforesaid, and the said William Holland pray that the said John Riggini to his Declaration aforesaid may answer, and the aforesaid John Riggini altho' solemnly called Cometh not, nor nothing says in Bar or prevention of the aforesaid of the aforesaid William for that the said William remaineth against the aforesaid John howsoever aforesaid be. —
