All which said Next Court to wit the twentieth day of June anno domini: One thousand Seven hundred and thirti two came againe as well the aforesaid John Outerbridge by his attorney aforesaid as the said Nathaniel Horsay by his attorney aforesaid and the said Nathaniel Horsay as before defendant the force and injury whereto and saith that he did not assume upon himselfe in manner and forme as the aforesaid above against him he hath complained and of this he puts himselfe upon the Country her and the aforesaid John Outerbridge in like manner —

Therupon Command is Given to the Jno. of Somerset County that I immediately no cause to come hys twelve dñe by whomes who neither be to recognized because as well the afterwards in the same Court came the said Jno. to wit Joshua Caldwell Jr. and made Return that he had - his ready twelve dñe as by his said precept he was commanded, and afterwards in same day and year last mentioned came as well the aforesaid John as the aforesaid Nathaniel by their attorney's aforesaid and the Juror of that same Jury impannelled being called came to wit Edward Rownd James Memorie, John Donelson, Cannon Wm right Robert Middle, Thomas Bonner Samuel Hopkins, John Webb Richard Knight Thomas Collins Joseph Moller and William Farrel Jr. who to say the truth in the premises being elected tryed and sworn - whereupon the praiser of the aforesaid John and by the consent of the same Nathaniel by their attorney's aforesaid Edward Rownd the first person whom on a jury aforesaid, is withdrawn, and all the rest of the Jurors aforesaid are discharged & whereupon the dispute in the action aforesaid is at the prayer of the aforesaid Plaintiff and defendant referred to Edward Rownd, John Donelson and Samuel Hopkins Jnd. Gent or any two of them according to the Statute in such case provided, and then and in the meantime by them or any two of them to be made and returned immediately to this Court, and Judgment to be given thereon but and afterwards in the same Court came the aforesaid Edward Rownd, John Donelson and Samuel Hopkins Jnd. the arbitrators named in the aforesaid rule of reference and made return to this Court here that they find the Balance due to the aforesaid John Outerbridge Nine pounds twelve shillings and Seven pence curr. money from the aforesaid Nathaniel Horsay &c —

Whereupon the aforesaid Nathaniel Horsay by his attorney aforesaid says that he cannot hanise the action aforesaid of the aforesaid John Outerbridge, nor can he say but that the same Nathaniel did assume upon himselfe in manner and forme as the aforesaid John above against him complained and as to the damage of the same John by him by reason of the premises in that part sustained the same Nathaniel says and confesseth that the aforesaid John has sustained damages by occasion of the premises in that part apposse to the aforesaid Nine pounds twelve shillings and Seven pence currant money and not more and because the aforesaid John doth not thinke but the same allegation confesseth to be true prayeth and those damages above confesseth toge: ther with his costs and charges aforesaid to him adjudged he therefore by present of the
