 Thomas in Consideration there of the day and Year of at Somerset County of
 within the Jurisdiction aforesaid upon himselfe did assume and to the Said Moses then and

 pence to the Said Moses when he should be therunto requested he well and faithfully pay and
 Content Never the less the Said Thomas his promise and Assumption a^t in forme
 aforesaid made Nothing Regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the Said
 Moses in that f^l Casfully and Subtly to Deceive and Defraud the a^t four
 pounds Nine Shillings and Six pence to the Said Moses Altho the Same to
 do the Said Thomas by the aforesaid Moses on the a^t tenth day of July in the
 Year a^t and often afterwards at Somerset County of within the Jur. of a^t he was
 there to Required hath not paid or to him for the Same in any Sort Contented
 but the Same to him hitherto to pay or any Sort to Content hath Refused and
 Still doth Refuse and Deny Whereupon he Saith he is worse and hath Damage
 Damage to the Value of Eight Pound Money aforesaid and thereupon he brings
 Suit &c.
