Somerset County sh John Stewart Junr by Francis Allen his Attorney Complain
of James Shirley Gent: one of the Attorneys of the County Court of the Right Hon^{ble}
the Lord Proprietary here present here in Court in his own proper person otherwise
called James ^{Shirley} of Somerset County and Province aforesaid Gent: for that the aforesaid James
doth Unjustly detain and hath not rendered to the said John two thousand pounds
March: Tobacco in Cash w^{ch} he oweth for that whereas the aforesaid James the tenth
day of Septemb^r: one thousand seven hundred thirty and one at the County of
Somerset aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing obligatory did
acknowledge himself to be bound unto the said John in the aforesaid two thousand
pounds of tobacco in Cash to be paid the said John when he should be there unto.
Requested yet the said James tho' often required the said two thousand pounds of
Tobacco in Cash to the said John hath not rendered but the same to him hither to be
rendered hath Denied and still doth deny and Unjustly Detain to the Damage of
the said John fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco aforesaid and thereupon he prayeth
and brings into Court here the Writing aforesaid which Debt aforesaid in form aforesaid doth
witness whose date is the day and year aforesaid - And the aforesaid James Shirley
by Levin Gale his Attorney Comes and Defends the force and Injury when
and prays Leave thereof to Imparle here untill the Next Court and he hath it and
the same day is given to the aforesaid John here also - At which said Next Court to
will the twentieth day of June Ann^d Domⁿ: one thousand seven hundred and
thirty two Came againe as well the aforesaid John Stewart as the aforesaid James Shirley
by their Attorneys aforesaid and the said James Shirley says that the Justices of the
Lord Proprietary here to proceed in the Cause aforesaid between him the said John
Stewart
