one Shillings and one penny in Equall parts according to act of Assembly when  
they shall arrive at full age to receive the same then the above Obligation  
to be void and of none Effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue -

John Magan . . . . In hand John Magan Late of Somerset County Schoolmaster of he should  
befound in his daily walk and him should safekeep so that he might have his body before  
the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third  
Wednesday of June then next to satisfie unto Nathaniel Brittingham of five pounds seven shillings  
and four pence current money and two hundred and Seventy four pounds of store which to the  
same Nathaniel in the same Court before the Justice had of at dividig Creek were adjudged for  
his damage which he had by reason of a certain promise and assumption to the same Nat. by  
the aforesaid John made and not performed whereof he is present -

All which said sum herday of June to wit the twentieth day of the same month One thousand  
Seven hundred and Ninety two gave the Sher: of Somerset County and the abd Nat Brittingham  
and said Sher: made to him of the said Writ hereof directed to him in these words following.  
R. Rogers Joshua Baldwin Sher:

wherupon the aforesaid John Magan present having sent in his proper person to the prayer of  
the aforesaid Nathaniel Brittingham committed into his custody of the Sher: of Somerset County  
to remain while the said Nathaniel Brittingham of the damage aforesaid should be fully satisfie  
the said Sher: to wit Jos: Baldwin present having took charge of said abd Magan accordingly &c.
