

W.B. Thom: Selby - Command was given to the Sher: of Somerset County that he should take
 & H. Benj: Houston Benjamin Houston late of Somerset County Planter if he should be
 found in his bailwick and him should safekeep so that he might have his body
 before his Justice of ^{his Lordships} County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third
 tuesday of Novemb: then Next to answer unto Thomas Selby of Aplea of
 trespass upon the case and that thereof he should not fail: -

All which said third tuesday of Novemb: to witt the sixteenth day of the same
 Ann Dom one thousand seven hundred and thirty one being the day of the
 Returne of the said Writt Cometh the aft Thomas Selby by ^{Wm. Dickinson} his
 attorney and the Sher: of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was -

Directed ^{Lijawise} comes and makes Returne thereof to the Court here Endorsed ^{Virt. Capi Capus}
 force and doing where and prays Leave there of ^{And the said Benjamin Houston by his attorney} to the
 Court to witt the twenty first day of March Ann Dom: one

thousand seven hundred and thirty one came again as well the aforesd Tho:
 Selby as the aforesd Benj: Houston by their attorneys aforesd and the aft Benj:
 prays further Leave there of to Impar to here untill the Next Court and he
 hath it and the same day is given unto the aft Thom: here also: -

All which said next Court to witt the twentieth day of June and Dow. One thousand seven hund:
 red and thirty two came again as well the aforesd Benj: Houston as well the aforesd
 Thomas Selby as the aforesd Benjamin Houston by their attorneys aforesd, and who upon the
 aforesd Thomas Selby who offered the writ aforesd against the aforesd Benjamin Houston late
 of Somerset County planter in the aft plea of trespass upon the case he did not present his
 writ aforesd -

Therefore he and his pledge of preventing be in mercy and he left no:
 iminate pledge, he and that the aforesd Benj: Houston recover against the aforesd Thomas
 Selby ^{Houston} his damage by Quasion of the premises aft to
 pounds of tobacco to the same Benj: Houston by direction of the

Justice here at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of
 the Statute he by the Court here adjudged he -

John Atkinson Command was given to the Sher: of Somerset County that of the goods and Chattels which were of
 Tobias Pepper Tobias Pepper late of Somerset County planter ad. dicit. Tobias Pepper planter of Somerset
 County in the province of Maryland in his bailwick he should make as well a certain debt
 of two thousand five hundred and twelve pounds of good port which John Atkinson in his Lordships County
 Court of Somerset at dividing Creek Recovered against him as of three hundred and twenty eight pounds of
 tobacco which to the same John Atkinson in the same Court were adjudged for his damage which he had by Quasion
 of the detention of that same debt and the same port and tobacco the same Sher: should have before the
 Justice
