It is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Aberilla Beal pay to his said Lordship the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary (for the Use of Somerset County) for her fine by the Court here upon her imposed for and by Occasion of the premises aforesaid whatsoever in form aforesaid he is found thirty pounds of current money and that the said Aberilla Beal be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid &c. ordered by the Court that the said Aberilla give Security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by Occasion of the premises aforesaid whereupon certain Thomas Beal of Somerset County planter present here in Court undertakes for the said Aberilla to pay the several Officers their fees due by Occasion of the premises &c. Likewise the said Aberilla is ordered to give Security for her appearance from day to day during this term to give evidence against a certain Avery Morgan. — Thereupon the said Aberilla Beal with Thomas Beal her Security both present here in Court and acknowledged their oaths to give and be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the Sum of ten pounds.
