for his appearance at November Court next to answer his begetting abashed Child on the body
of Elizabeth and Bridgett Phillips &c. Whereupon the aforesaid Furniv Deane with Stephen Deane
of Somerset County planters his security both present before Court in their proper persons acknow-
ledged themselves to owe and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the right honorable the Lord
Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their goods and chattels Lands and tenements
separately to be made and levied for the use of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs
and Successors If it happen the aforesaid Furniv Deane do not make his personal appear-
ance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Durdridge next or
third Tuesday of November next and do not answer unto the said Lord Proprietary of and concern-
ing his begetting abashed Child of the body of the said Bridgett Phillips and do not stand and
abide the Judgment of the Court thereon, and do depart the same Court with Leave thereof &c.

His Lordship } Somerset County p. Be it remembered that this eighteenth day of August in the Year
of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came into Court Thomas
Samuel Wilson... } Black Gent: who prosector for the Lord Proprietary and gives this Court to under-
stand and be informed that Samuel Wilson Late of Somerset County Gent. the Seventeenth day of
August in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two at Somerset County &c.
in and upon a certain Thomas Lord in the peace of God and the aforesaid Lord Proprietary there
where being an assault made and him beat wounded and cruelly intreated so that off his Life it was
greatly despaired and other Enormities to him the said Thomas then and there offered to ~~the great~~
Damage of him the said Thomas and against the peace of the right honorable the Lord Proprietary &c. wherefore
the said Thomas Black for said Lord Proprietary prays Damages of & Court &c.

Thereupon Command was given to the Justices of Somerset County that he should take the said Samuel
Wilson if he to answer &c. and afterwards to wit this eighteenth day of August and about One thou-
sand Seven hundred and thirty two came before Court the aforesaid Samuel Wilson in his proper per-
son and being instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the premises above upon
him imposed, says that of the premises aforesaid above upon him imposed he is guilty thereof
whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood. It is
considered by the Court here that the said Samuel Wilson pay to his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary
for his fine for and by occasion of the trespass and assault &c. whereof he is guilty aforesaid the
sum of two shillings and six pence current money, and that the said Samuel Wilson be taken to
satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid &c.
