His Lordship - } Somerset County J. Be it remembered that this fifteenth day of August in the Year of our  
Heber Whittingham } Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came into Court Thomas Bluet Gent. who  
prosecutes for the Lord proprietary and gives this Court to understand and be informed that  
Heber Whittingham late of the County of Somerset planter the tenth day of August in the Year of our Lord -  
One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two at Somerset County aforesaid in and upon a certain Mary Holoy in  
the peace of God and the aforesaid Lord proprietary then and there being an assault made and her body wound-  
ed and evilly entreated so that after Life it was greatly despaired and other enormities to her the said  
Mary and against the peace of the right honorable the Lord proprietary &c.

Whereupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take & said Heber  
Whittingham if he to answer &c. and afterwards (to wit) this fifteenth day of August and died. One thou-  
sand Seven hundred and thirty two came hereto Court the aforesaid Heber Whittingham in his proper person  
and hath alsoing of the Information afo and being instantly demanded how he would acquit himself  
of the premises aforesaid above upon him imposed, says that of the premises aforesaid above upon him  
imposed he is guilty thereof and the premises in the Information afo expressly confesseth -

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court have been heard and fully understood. It is Consid-  
ered by the Court that the aforesaid Heber Whittingham pay to his said Lordship the Lord proprietary  
for his fine for and by occasion of the trespass and assault afo whereof in form aforesaid he is convicted one  
hundred pounds of 100. and that the said Heber Whittingham be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of  
the fine aforesaid. Whereupon the said Heber Whittingham is committed into the custody of the Sher. of  
Somerset County there to remain until the fine afo is satisfied and the several Officer's fees due by occasion  
of the premises. Joshua Redwell Sher. present before Court took Charge of the said Heber Whittingham  
and so forth

Gabriel Stewart and his associates Justices of the same Court Thomas Bluet Gent. who prosecutes for the Lord pro-  
prietary and gives this Court to understand and be informed that Gabriel Stewart of & said  
County Chirington the tenth day of August in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty one  
in the County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a certain Ann May-  
comb of the County aforesaid Spinster and on the body of the said Ann then and there did begett a bastard  
Child to the high displeasure of Almighty God and to the bad example of all others in such cases offending  
and against the form of the act of aforesaid in such cases made and provided wherefore the same Thomas  
Bluet prays & advise of the Court in the premises and that due process of Law thereon against the said  
Gabriel Stewart to issue

Thereupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the  
said Gabriel Stewart if he to answer &c. and afterwards (to wit) the fifteenth day of August and died
