Whereupon the said Ephraim Wilson by his attorney aforesaid prays that forasmuch as he has complied with the Law in order to an attachment he may have Judgment against the said Nathaniel Forke, James Berie, and John Wood administrators of the Goods and Chattels of the said Hugh Arbuthnot at the time of his death to be administered for his damages aforesaid by way of attachment according to act of Assembly &c. And forasmuch as it appears to the Court here that the aforesaid Ephraim has complied with the Law as alleged -

340 Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Ephraim Wilson - recover against the said Nathaniel Forke, James Berie and John Wood his damages up to twelve pounds three shillings and five pence Sterling as also all costs and charges by the said party laid out and expended about his suit by way of attachment against the goods Chattels Rights ^{or Credits} of the said Hugh Arbuthnot at the time of his death remaining to be administered according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided &c. ---

And whereupon the said Samuel by Thomas Bluet his Attorney Complaines for that to witt When the said Hugh Arbuthnot in his Life time and the said Jeffery Long the Testat: in his Life time to witt the thirtieth Day of August ~~and~~ In the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty one at Somerset County of together accounted of Divers Sums of Money to the said Jeffery Long in his Life time by the said Hugh Arbuthnot
