And whereupon the said Charles by Francis Allen Esq. attorney doth plead
that whereas the said Joseph the first day of March of this said last year
hundred or twenty five acres of land in Southwest County of and within the jurisdiction
of this Court in consideration that he the said Charles at the special instance
and request of the said Jones before that time had sold to the said Joseph
certain land in the said County of and within the jurisdiction of this Court
of the value of five hundred pounds the said Jones the said Charles thereupon
promised and faithfully promised the said Charles that he the
said Jones would satisfy and pay to the said Charles the sum of
three hundred pounds to be worth two pound ten shillings current money of
Maryland. Nevertheless the said Jones by promise or assumption
