And the aforesaid John Harper by Levi Gale his attorney comes and prays Leave to Impede to the petition aforesaid and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Murray here also &c.

At which said Next Court to wit the twentieth day of June and Dow. One thousand Seven Hundred and thirty two came againe as well the aforesaid John Murray as the aforesaid John Harper by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said John Harper prays further Leave thereof to Impede here, until next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Murray here also &c.

At which said Next Court to wit the fifteenth day of August and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the aforesaid John Murray as the aforesaid John Harper by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here being seen heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had, as well on the part of the said John Murray as on the part of the said John Harper, and what was delibered upon both in relation to the premises aforesaid — wherefore it is Considered by the Court that the aforesaid former Judg<sup>t</sup> be confirmed, and that the said John Murray take nothing by his petition aforesaid and further it is Considered that the aforesaid John Harper recover against the aforesaid Murray 168. One hundred and Sixty Eight -- pounds of Tobacco for his costs and Charges by him about his defence in that part exposed according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.
