At which said next Court to witte the twentieth day off June ann Dowd One thousand seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the aforsaid Sarah Brittenian as the Aforesaid Thomas Caldwell by their attorney, aforsaid and hereupon the said Thomas Caldwell pray, further Leave to ^{keep} impark his untill next court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforsaid Sarah her also &c.

At which said next Court to wit the fifteenth day of August ann^d D^o One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the aforesaid Sarah Brittain as the aforesaid Thomas Caldwell by their attorney aforesaid and who upon the said Thomas as before defend, the force and injury when hee and says that he cannot hamisay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Sarah nor but that he did assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the aforesaid Sarah above against him Complained and as to the damage of the same Sarah by her by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Thomas says and Confesseth that the aforesaid Sarah has sustained damages by occasion of the premises further than his costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part appoyed to ten pounds Curr. money of America and not more. and because the aforesaid Sarah deny's not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true pray Judgment and those damages above Confessed together with his costs and Charges ad to him adjudged &

Therefore by consent of the parties, it is considered that the said Sarah Brittain Recover
against the aforesaid Thomas Cadwell her damages aforesaid to the aforesaid ten pounds current money
of America by the same Thomas in manner and form aforesaid Confessed as also Two hundred
and thirty three pounds of tobacco for her costs and Charges aforesaid to the same -
