Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your bailiwick you make
known unto the Person or Persons in whose hands you make the
Same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices
of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or
they have why the Same goods Chattells Rights or Credits so Attach
ed in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution
thereof --
