his Care and possession all the Estate, which of Right, doth belong unto the said Mathias Dashiell both Real and personall, and that the said George Dashiell give Security according to act of Assembly for to comply with the Guardianship aforesaid.

Thereupon the said George Dashiell with James Dashiell (his security) of Somerset County Gent: both present here in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the said Mathias Dashiell in fifty pounds Sterling Each of their body's Goods or Chattels, Land and Tenements severally to be made and Levied to the Use of the said Mathias Dashiell his heirs and assigns. It is happened that the said George Dashiell do not comply with the Law in relation to the Guardianship aforesaid, and do not deliver up unto the said Mathias Dashiell his heirs or assigns all his estate both Real and personall that he should have in his hands or possession, peaceably and Quietly when his place arrives at full age to receive the same &c.

Proclamation being made in usual form, His Lordship's Commission of the peace for the County of Somerset being produced was openly read in these words following vizt

Lord Baron of Baltimore To Robert King, William Smith, John Smith, Ball, Hundred William Stough,
John John Caldwell, John Mufferson, John Randy, James Dashiell, John Scott, James Martin, William Lane, Thomas Williams, Henry Ballard and David Wilson of Somerset County Gent: greeting Know
Ye that we have assigned you and every of you jointly and severally our Justices to keep our peace within our County of Somerset and to do Equall Law and Right to all the Kings Subjects Rich and Poor according to the Laws Customs and Directions of the acts of Assembly of this Province so far forth as they provide and where they are silent according to Laws Statutes and Reasonable Customs of England as used and practised within this Province for the Conservation of the peace and Quiet Rule and Government of the Kings Subjects within our said County and to chastize and punish all or any person or persons offending against the said Acts Laws Statutes and Customs or any of them.
