Mathew Dashiel | son and prays that he may be admitted to chose a certain George Dashiel
of Somerset County Gent: as his Guardian which is granted him &c. Whereupon the said Mathew
Dashiel did make Rose of his said George Dashiel as his Guardian accordingly &c.
Whereupon it is ordered by this Court here that the said George Dashiel take into
his care and possession all his Estate, which of Right doth belong unto the said Mathew -
Dashiel both real and personal, and that the said George have security according to act of
Assembly for to comply with his Gardening aforesaid &c. —
Thereupon the said George Dashiel with James Dashiel (his security) of Somerset County
Gent. both present here in Court acknowledged him selfe to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto
the said Mathew Dashiel in fiftie pounds Sterling each of them bodye Goods or Chattels Land
& Ckeaments severally to be made and levied to the use of the said Mathew Dashiel his heirs and
aspynes. If it happen that the said George Dashiel do not comply with the Law in relation to the
aforesaid, and do not deliver up unto the said Mathew Dashiel his heirs or aspynes all
his estate, both real and personal that he shall have in his hands, or possession, peaceably and
quietly when his place arre at full age to receive the same &c.

Proclamation being made in usual form, His Lordships Commission of the peace for
County of Somerset being produced was openly read in these words following diet

Directions of the acts of Assembly of the Province so far forth as they provide
and where they are silent According to Lawes Statutes and Reasonable cus-
toms of England as used and practised within this Province for the Con-
servation of the peace and Quiet Rule and Government of the Kings Subjects
within our said County and to Chastize and Punish all or any person or persons
offending against the said acts Lawes Statutes and Customs or any of them
according
