County besit whensoever or wheresoever to be holden there to be tryed and we command
you and Every of you Diligently to intend the keeping the peace Acts of Assembly
Laws Customs and Statutes aforesd and all and Every the Premises and that at your
County Courts you make Inquisition and hear and Determine as aforesd doing therein
what to Justice appertaines according to the Laws Customs and Directions of the Acts
of Assembly aforesd so far forth as they provide and where they are silent according
to the Laws Statutes and Reasonable Customs of England as used and practised
within this Province and further we do constitute ordain and appoint you the said
Robert King, W^m Faust John Smith Ball^t Hundred W^m Stoughton, John Caldwell,
John McClester John Handy, James Dashiel, John Scott, James Martin, W^m
Lane, Thomas Williams, Henry Ballard, and David Wilson or any three or more
of you as aforesd to give out writs precepts, processes and attachments and hold Plea
of all Actions popular and of all Actions personal of what sort soever wherein
the Demand doth not exceed the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling or thirty
thousand pounds of tobacco and all Actions personal now depending before
you and after Judgment Execution to award in all such cases and actions
aforesd according to the Laws Customs and Directions of the acts of Assembly
aforesd so far forth as they provide and where they are silent according to the
Laws Statutes and Reasonable Customs of England as used and practised
within this Province in which said Actions so to be tryed we do constitute ordain
and appoint you the said Robert King, W^m Faust John Smith Ball^t,
Hundred W^m Stoughton, John Caldwell, John McClester, John Handy,
James Dashiel, John Scott, James Martin, W^m Lane, Thomas
Williams, Henry Ballard, David Wilson and none others to be Judges
