until he arrives at the age of twenty one years, the said Lewis Bowelle being eighteen
Year of age, the said Lewis Bowelle to serve his said Master William Bowelle the first term aforesaid during
which term, the said Lewis Bowelle his said Master well and faithfully shall serve, his secrets keep his command-
ments lawfully and honestly every where willingly shall do, and in all things as good and faithful Servant shall
demean himself towards his said Master and all his during the term aforesaid &c —

In consideration of which service the said William Bowelle present here in Court covenanteth with
the Justices of the same Court, in Court judicially sitting, on behalf of the said Lewis Bowelle that he the
said William Bowelle during the term aforesaid will learn his said apprentice the trade of a house Carpen-
ter, and to Read write and cypher as far as the rule of three inclusive, and at the Expiration of his
servitude give his said apprentice anew suit of Cloathes over and above his common weareing Cloathes, and
likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing and all other necessa-
ries sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the aforesaid William Bowelle give security for to
comply with the covenants aforesaid &c —

Whereupon the said William Bowelle with John Webb and Bruffe Broughton of somerset County plan-
ter his security, are present before Court in their proper persons acknowledging themselves to owe
Stand Justly indebted unto the said Lewis Bowelle in Thirty pounds Sterling Duly and Severally,
of thiderby, goods and Chattells, Land, and tenements to be made and levied to the use of the said
Lewis Bowelle his heirs and assignees. If it happen that the aforesaid William Bowelle do not during
the term aforesaid learn his said apprentice his trade of a house Carpenter, and to Read write and
cypher as far as the rule of three inclusive, and at the Expiration of his servitude do not give
him another suit of Cloathes, over and above his common weareing Cloathes, and do not likewise provide
for his said apprentice meat, drink, washing, Lodging, and Cloathing and all other necessaries, sufficient
for such an apprentice to have and wear, during the term aforesaid &c —
