In consideration of which service the said William Bowell present herein Court Covenanteth with
the Justices of the same Court, in Court Judicially sitting, on behalf of the said Levin Bowell that he the
said William Bowell during the term aforesaid will Learn his said apprentice the trade of a house Carpenter
:ter, and to Read Write and Cypher as far as the rule of three Inclusive, and at the Expiration of his
servitude give his said apprentice a new Suit of Cloathes over and above his common wearing Coats, and
Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Bathing and all other necessary
:ry's sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid William Bowell give Security for to
comply with the covenants aforesaid &c.

Thereupon the said William Bowell with John Webb and Bruffe Broughton of Somerset County plant
:ers his Securitys all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to take
Stand Justly Indebted unto the said Levin Bowell in thirty pounds Sterling Justly and Severally
of their bodies, goods, and Chattels, Land, and tenements to be made and Levied to the Use of the said
Levin Bowell his heirs and assigns. If it happen that the said William Bowell do not during
the term aforesaid Learn his said apprentice the trade of a house Carpenter, and to Read write and
Cypher as far as the rule of three Inclusive, and at the Expiration of his servitude do not give
him a new Suit of Cloathes, over and above his common wearing Coats, and do not Likewise provide
for his said apprentice, meat, drink, washing, Lodging, and Bathing and all other necessarys, sufficient
for such an apprentice, to have and wear, during the term aforesaid &c.
