and Thomas Brown all of Somerset County Gents. be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to all }  
assemblies in such case made and provided &c.

two Lane the said Betty Game in her proper person, and likewise take her into Court Lewis Gale Esq. who for his said }  
Lordship in this behalf prosecutes, and saith her in Court that he will not further prosecute against the said Betty }  
Game on the presentment aforesaid. wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Betty Game be quiet & }  
goe thereof without day - whereupon the said Betty Game is advised to give Security for the severall Officers fees }  
due upon the presentment &c. Therupon a certain Stephen Wainwright of Somerset County Bricklayer or propagator }  
bring in Court under seal for the said Betty Game to pay the severall Officers fees due by means of the presentment &c. &c.
