



Shilling and Six pence Current money to be paid unto the said Arthur, Planter
Prisilla Jeph and Zerobable King, their heirs Es^t Adm^t or assignes to the which
payment well and truly to be made and done we bind over ourselves and either of our heirs
Es^t and Adm^t for the whole and in the whole jointly and severally firmly by these
presents sealed with our seal and dated this 22nd Day of November Anno Domini 1732
The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Commissary Generall
hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the estate of Upster King dec^d wherein
it is found that there is Balance due to the above said Orphans the sum of three hun-
dred and twenty six pounds eighteen shillings and nine pence current Money if there-
fore the abovesaid W^m Turpin Jun^r his heirs Es^t or Adm^t shall and do well and truly
Pay or cause to be paid unto the above named Arthur, Planter, King, Prisilla King,
Jeph King and Zerobable King the aforesaid sum of three hundred and twenty six pounds
Eight shillings and nine pence current Money to be paid them according to the dec^d
will and the act of Assembly in such case provided when they shall arrive at full age
