Be it remembered that the twenty fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty two came into Court Thomas Bluet Gent: who prosecutes for the Lord Proprietary and gives this Court to Understand and be Informed that a certain Henry Mills Late of the County of Somerset Planter the first Day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty two at Somerset County aforesaid did Import in this Province to witt into the County of Somerset aforesaid one Negro Slave and did not pay unto the Novell Officer of the County aforesaid the Sum of twenty Shillings Sterling toward Defraying the Publick Charge of this Province whereby the said Henry hath forfeited to the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary the Sum of five Pounds Sterling to be Recovered in any Court of Record in this Province by Action of Debt Bill Plaint or Information Wherfore the Said Thom: Bluet prays the Advice of the Court Concerning the Premises, and that Due Process May Issue

Therupon Command was given to the Just. of Somerset County that he should take the said Henry Miles if he should be found in his Bailly witt and him should safe Keep so that he might have his body before his Lordships County Court of Somerset
