five Pence Sterling and Eight hundred pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same Attachment or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of Novemb: Next then and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and for the Use of a certain Ephraim Wilson unless <sup>he pay</sup> Nathaniel Goche, James Leisce and Wood Adm: of Hugh Arbuthnot Sec: by themselves or their Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Ephraim Wilson in a plea of Trespass upon the Case according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto <sup>the</sup> Person or Persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution there of had and made according to act of Assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this Writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the Day and Place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writt Witness Robert King Gent: Chief Justices of our said Court the Thirteenth Day of August In the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion <sup>of Great Brittain</sup> Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two.

At which said third Tuesday of November to witt the twenty first day of the same month and day one thousand seven hundred and thirty two being the day of the return of the said Writt came the said Ephraim Wilson by Levi Gale his attorney and the sh. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writt was directed likewise came and made Return thereof to the Court here endorsed in these words following vid: By virtue of the within Writt to me directed to the Justice within mentioned I certify that on the ninth day of November one thousand seven hundred and thirty two I have attached in the hands of William Thompson to the value of twelve pounds three shillings and pence Sterling and Eight hundred pounds of Tobacco as of the rights and Credits of said debt. and further I certify that by John Thompson and William Horsey Lawfull men of my Bailiwick that I have made known unto the said Wm. Thompson that he be and appear at the place and time within contained to show Cause by the within Writt if an Comanded.

Whereupon the said Wm: Thompson (Attorney in fact of Andrew Thompson) Garnishes of the aforesaid Nathaniel Goche, James Leisce and John Wood Adm: of the aforesaid Hugh Arbuthnot Sec: by Thomas Bluett his Attorney comes and says that he cannot Garnish but that the said Wm: Thompson (as Attorney in fact, of the aforesaid Andrew Thompson) has of the Rights and Credits of the said Nathaniel Goche, James Leisce and John Wood Adm: as aforesaid, to the value of twelve pounds three shillings
