Tobacco and When you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody Safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third tuesday of November next then and to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the use of a certain Samuel Long Executor of the last Will and testament of George Long Deed Unless the said Nathaniel Gorke, James Pearce, John Wood Adm<sup>r</sup> of the said Hugh Arbutnott Deed by themselves or their Attorney Shall appear and answer unto me in a plea of trespass upon the said according to Law and that good Lawfull men of your County you make known unto the Person or Persons in whose hands you make the same attachment and that he She or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he She or they have why the same goods Chattells Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided is to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you Shall execute this writ that you make unto our said Justices at the Day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writ witness Robert King gent<sup>r</sup> Chief Justice of our said Court the Nineteenth Day of August in the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two . . .

At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the twenty first day of the same month and year One thousand Seven hundred and Thirty two being the day of the return of the said Writ against the said Samuel Long by his attorney aforesaid and the Justices of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise cause and made return thereof to the said Writ and endorsed in these words following vizt By virtue of the within writ to me directed to the Justice within mentioned I certify that I have attested in the hands of William Thompson to the value of Six pounds Three shillings Sterling and Six hundred pounds of tobacco, and further certify that by John de Wilton Esq<sup>r</sup> and Lawfull men of my County I have made known unto the said William Thompson that he be and appear at the time and place within contained to show for as by the within writ is commanded . . . . . Joshua Goldwell s<sup>r</sup> . . .

Whereupon the said W<sup>m</sup> Thompson (Attorney in fact of Andrew Thompson) Garnished of the aforesaid Nathaniel Gorke, James Pearce, and John Wood, Adm<sup>r</sup> of the aforesaid Hugh Arbutnott Deed by Levin Galt his Attorney comes and says that he cannot gain say but that the said W<sup>m</sup> Thompson (as Attorney in fact of the aforesaid Andrew Thompson) has of the Rights and Credits of the said Nathaniel Gorke, James Pearce, and John Wood Adm<sup>r</sup> to the Value of Six pounds three Shillings and six hundred pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid; nor but the same ought to be condemned in the hands of the same W<sup>m</sup> Thompson (as Attorney in fact)
