Richard Doulney late of Somerset County Planter if they shall be found in your  
Daily work to the Value of Eleven Pounds ten Shillings in Silver or Gold and Six  
hundred Pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part  
thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our  
Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of -  
Novemb<sup>r</sup> Next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the  
use of A certain John Collins Unles<sup>t</sup> the said Richard Doulney by himself or his  
attorney shall appear and answer unto the said John Collins of A plea of trespass  
upon the case & according to Law and that by good and lawfull men of your daily work  
you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same -  
Attached that he she or they <sup>be</sup> and appear before our Justices of our County Court to  
be held at Dividing Creek to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same -  
goods shall be Rights or Creditts so attached in her or their hands ought not to be condem-  
ned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such -  
case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you -  
execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the Day and  
place aforesaid and have you then and thare this Writ witness Robert King Gent<sup>l</sup> Just<sup>c</sup>  
of our said Court the Nineteen Day of August In the Eighteenth Year of our  
Dominion<sup>r</sup> Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two

At which said third Tuesday of Novemb<sup>r</sup> to will the twenty first Day of the same  
month Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty two being the day of  
the Returne of the said Writ came the said John Collins by Robert Jenkins -  
Henry his Attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt  
was Directed Likewise came and made returne thereto the Court here endorsed  
in the words following Vizt. By vertue of the within writt to me Directed to the  
Justices within mentioned I Certifie that on the <sup>ninth</sup> Day of Octob<sup>r</sup> Anno Domini  
Seven hundred and thirty two I attached in hands of Thomas Bowden fifty Shill-  
ings Current Money in the hands of W<sup>m</sup> West thirty Shillings Current Money -  
In the hand of George Howard ten Shilling Like money and I further Certifie  
that by Littleton Towne and Richard Roe Good and lawfull men of my  
Cailywick I have made known unto the said Thomas Bowden W<sup>m</sup> West and  
George Howard that they be and appear all the time and place within contained  
as by the within Receipt Jam Commanded so answer - Joshua Colverell

And whereupon the aforesaid Thomas Bowden garnishee of the aforesaid Richard Doulney appears in his  
proper person and says that he cannot garnishe but that he has of the Rights and Creditts of the said R<sup>d</sup>.  
Doulney in his hands, Ninety One bushells and three pecks of Indian Corn, which is valued by his self to forty  
two shillings and four pence Current Money, - Likewise the aforesaid William West garnishee of the aforesaid Richard  
Doulney appears.
